Suggested Kit List

This kit list is a suggested list of items for your son or daughter to take to on a summer camp in the UK. Please review this list for any additional items that they think may be required, as this is a suggested list only.

Equipment **Additional information** Rucksack Make sure everything is in a large enough rucksack. Try to avoid tying things on the Davsack outside. □ Full uniform Walking Boots are important. They must be □ Sleep Mat (e.g. Karrimat) waterproof, have a good tread, and provide ankle support. Leather walking boots are needed when Sleeping bag you use an axe or saw - for example when Pillow collecting and preparing wood for the fire. Wash kit Electronic items, e.g. iPod, MP3, mobile phones are not allowed. If any are taken it is at your own risk. Tea towel Please label all bags and items with your child's □ T-shirts / shirts name. □ Jumpers / fleeces Pack a sun hat and sun cream. We are outside Fleece Coat all the time, so if it is sunny it is essential. Make sure you son or daughter knows how to apply it, Long trousers (not denim) and when they should apply it. □ Shorts If your son or daughter has long hair, please Underwear send them with a few spare hair bobbles to tie Socks their hair back. This is for when cooking so that hair does not dangle in the fire or on the stove Pyjamas and potentially catch fire. Walking socks The number of t-shirts, shorts and trousers etc Sun hat are up to you, but make sure they have some spare in case they get really mucky or wet. Waterproof coat A bin bag or old pillowcase is a useful addition for □ Waterproof trousers storing dirty clothes. (pillowcases allow the □ Gaiters clothes to 'breathe'!) □ Torch (with spare batteries) Walking boots □ Wellies (optional) □ Trainers/sandals/ 'Crocs' □ Plate, bowl, mug, cutlery □ First aid kit (PL's) □ Water bottle □ Suncream Insect Repellent Camping chair / stool □ Swimwear
